The product portfolio of the company includes Body in White and chassis, complex assembly systems and opening systems, as well as tooling, dies and other related services.

Environmental, social and good governance (ESG) criteria have been in Gestamp's DNA since its creation.


Gestamp supplies parts to the top car manufacturers that produce over 80% of vehicles at world level.




Gestamp provides critical parts to the world's largest manufacturers, which are crucial to the structure of light vehicles*.

Gestamp provides a **wide range of products**, mainly made of steel and other key materials that are integrated into the includes body in white of vehicles defining their structure. Gestamp's activity encompasses **all parts manufacturing processes**, thus covering the entire value chain. This fact, coupled with the company's development capacity, turn it into a **strategic partner** for its customers.

GESTAMP HAS THREE CORE BUSINESS UNITS:

BIW:

The includes body in white is the vehicle's key structure fitted with metal stamped parts that are subsequently welded into one another. body in white metal parts are classified into two groups: external parts and structural parts.

Chassis:

Chassis products are those making up the lower part of the vehicle's body in white and their design is determined by weight and the distribution of load. Chassis structures include metal stamps as well as a wide array of assembled parts. These structures are critical for the car's overall performance, consistency and safety. They influence the vehicle's noise, vibration, driving and impact handling, specifically.

Mechanisms:

After the acquisition of Edscha in 2010, Gestamp has become a leader in manufacturing mechanisms, offering a wide range of products that include parts such as hinges, electrical systems and control devices.


ESG

The company's raison d'être is to contribute to making mobility safer and cleaner, thanks to its work in the development, design and responsible manufacture of components for automobiles that are increasingly safer in the event of a collision, and lighter, which means better car performance and less environmental impact. This long history in ESG matters has allowed Gestamp to position itself as a leading company in terms of sustainability among companies in the automotive components sector and industrial companies in general.

- Gestamp is a pioneer company in the components sector in terms of sustainability reporting. In 2013, it was the first company among comparable international automotive suppliers to publish a Sustainability Report, which had been done previously.
- Gestamp is also the first Spanish company in the components sector to be included in the Dow Jones Sustainability Index (DJSI), participating voluntarily.
- To do this, Gestamp underwent the evaluation of S&P RobecoSAM for the DJSI, being the first in the components sector in Spain to do so and also to appear in the YearBook in the top 10 of the components sector.
- In this sense, Gestamp also has different alliances in terms of sustainability, forming part of key
 organizations such as the Spanish Business Council for Sustainability and Climate Change
 (Forética), the leading organization in sustainability and corporate social responsibility in Spain. It
 also actively participates in the Sernauto sustainability commission and in the development of
 the white paper "Contribution of the automotive components industry to sustainable
 development".
